- 1) Motion was made by Commissioner LaFleur, Seconded by Commissioner Boatright to approve the minutes of the December 17, 2018 Commissioner's Court Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously.
- 2) Received monthly report Constable Precinct # 1.
- 3) Received monthly report Constable Precinct #3.
- 4) Received monthly report Constable Precinct #4
- 5) Received Gonzales County Sheriff's Office 2018 Racial Profiling Report.
- 6) Received Tax Assessor-Collector continuing education certificate of completion for a period of January 2, 2018-January 1, 2019 as compliant with SB 546 requirement.
- 7) Motion was made by Commissioner LaFleur, seconded by Commissioner Brzozowski to approve Tax Assessor-Collector's monthly report. Motion was approved unanimously.

Motion was approved unanimously.
- 10) Motion was made by Commissioner LaFleur, seconded by Commissioner Brzozowski to appoint Tina Stevens as Local Government Records Management Officer. Motion was approved unanimously.
- 11) Motion was made by Commissioner Brzozowski, seconded by Commissioner LaFleur to approve finance agreement with Welch State Bank for the purchase of a 2018 John Deer 770G Motor Grader for Precinct 2. Motion was approved unanimously.
- 12) Motion was made by Commissioner Brzozowski, seconded by Commissioner Boatright to table until next meeting to take up for consideration and possible action, including the acceptance of the addition of a spur to CR 179 approximately ¼ of a mile long within a dedication of Public Interest in a Road or Right-of-Way –Precinct #4.
