

## **Republican and Democratic Primary Runoff Election on July 14, 2020**

**Application for ballots by mail were available starting JANUARY 1, 2020 from the County Clerk's office located at 427 St. George, Suite 200, TX 78629; you may call 830-672-2801 to request an application be mailed to you.**

THE NEW APPLICATION FOR A BALLOT BY MAIL CAN BE USED AS AN ANNUAL APPLICATION (ELECTIONS TAKING PLACE IN 2020), you must indicate on the application that is your wish. NEW Applications must be received NO LATER THAN FRIDAY (July 2, 2020); RECEIVED, NOT POSTMARKED! Beginning in 2017 applications received by the County MAY BE annual (if so indicated) and be forwarded to other election entities: If you marked runoff or annual on your application there is no need to apply again this year.

Mail ballots must be received by the County Clerk's office by ELECTION DAY (07/14/2020), BY MAIL; IN PERSON DELIVERY ON ELECTION DAY BY VOTER (ONLY VOTER) on ELECTION DAY (with proper identification presented).

APPLICATION FOR A BALLOT BY MAIL MUST MEET ONE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER; DISABILITY: CONFINEMENT IN JAIL OR EXPECTED ABSENCE FROM THE COUNTY ON ELECTION DAY AND DURING THE PERIOD OF EARLY VOTING. BALLOTS FOR THIS REASON MAY ONLY BE MAILED TO AN ADDRESS OUTSIDE OF THE COUNTY.

Ending..... (Friday) July 10, 2020 AT 4:45 PM (normal office hours for the Clerk's office)

**EARLY VOTING WILL NOT BE CONDUCTED ON JULY 3 IN HONOR OF JULY 4<sup>TH</sup>, INDEPENDENCE DAY**

You must be registered to vote 30 days prior to the election (Monday, June 15, 2020) is the last day to register to be eligible to vote. If you have moved, it is necessary that you contact the Voter Registrar's office to correct your address (830-672-2841)

IN ACCORDANCE WITH SENATE BILL SB14 EFFECTIVE JUNE 25<sup>TH</sup> 2013; ALL VOTERS MUST SHOW PHOTO IDENTIFICATION WHEN VOTING IN PERSON.

**APPROVED FORMS OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION ARE: Texas Driver's License; Texas Identification Card; Texas Concealed Handgun License; U.S. Passport (all may be expired up to 4 (four) years); U.S. Military Identification Card; U.S. Citizenship Certificate-with photo;**

**OR;**

**NEW: If you do not obtain and can't obtain one of the approved forms of identification above you may:(1) sign a Reasonable Impediment Declaration , and (2) providing one of various form of supporting documentation : certified birth certificate, a valid voter registration certificate, a copy or original of one of the following: current utility bill, bank statement, government check or paycheck or other government document that shows name and address of the voter. (ALTHOUGH government documents including photo MUST BE ORIGINAL and CANNOT BE COPIES.)**

If you do not have any of the above listed forms of ID; you may apply for an ELECTION IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATE from DPS driver's license office. (This card is only good for voting)
