PRO SE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING SMALL ESTATE AFFIDAVITS

- After you file the Small Estate Affidavit with the County Clerk, citation must be posted for 10 days before the Court can enter an Order. *Please ask the Probate Clerk the citation return date.*
- Pursuant to Estates Code §205.003, an Order Approving Small Estates Affidavit is required. You may find an Order on the Gonzales County Court web page: <u>www.co.gonzales.tx.us</u>. Under *Quick Links*, click on *County Officials, then click on County Judge* and locate the SEA Order under the Probate section. Fill out the Order completely. Failure to file the Order will result in your case being set for a dismissal docket.
- You may file the Order Approving Small Estate Affidavit <u>no sooner than 2 days prior to the</u> <u>citation return date</u>. You may drop off the Order with the Probate Clerk in the County Clerk's office.
- You will receive an email notification after the Judge approves or denies the Order. The notification is sent to the email address provided on the Pro Se Applicant's Information Form. We are unable to give a time frame on when the Order will be signed. Your patience is appreciated.
- You may obtain a copy of the Order from the County Clerk's office. You will be responsible for any fees. The County Clerk's number is 830-672-2801.
