- 1) Motion was made by Commissioner LaFleur, Seconded by Commissioner Whiddon to approve the minutes of the January 28, 2019 Commissioner's Court Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously.
- 2) Received monthly report Constable Precinct #1.
- 3) Received Full Exemption Racial Profiling Report- Gonzales County Constable Pct#1.
- 4) Received 2018 Racial Profiling Report-Gonzales County Constable Pct#4.
- 5) Received County Auditor's Monthly Report.
- 6) Motion was made by Commissioner LaFleur, seconded by Commissioner Brzozowski to approve Tax Assessor-Collector's monthly report. Motion was approved unanimously.
